“Clinical Trials Registry – India (CTRI)”

The Clinical Trials Registry - India (CTRI) is an online system for registration of all clinical trials being conducted in the country. This web based system (www.ctri.nic.in) has its headquarters at the National Institute of Medical Statistics (NIMS), Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR). It serves as a platform for registering all clinical trials on health products including drugs, devices, vaccines, herbal drugs etc. The registration of trials in CTRI is free of cost and crucial information of these registered clinical trials is freely searchable from the CTRI site.

The CTRI currently registers interventional trials as well as BA/BE and observational studies. While the mandate is to register trials prospectively, the CTRI also registers ongoing and completed trials. The primary objective of the registry is to enhance transparency, accountability and accessibility of clinical trials and their results. However, there are several other benefits as well.

Trial registration in the CTRI is highly technical and specialized process. Trial submitted to the CTRI are reviewed by the CTRI scientists and each data set point assessed for valid and relevant entries prior to registration. Applications are invited from the eligible candidates in the prescribed format for the following post in the Clinical Trials Registry – India (CTRI). The post is co-terminus with the project.

1. Scientist C (One)

Qualification (Essential)

Post graduate degree (MD/MS/DNB) after MBBS with one year experience OR Postgraduate diploma in medical subjects after MBBS with two years' experience OR MBBS Degree with four years' experience in medical subjects after MBBS Degree

OR

1st Class Post Graduate degree and Ph.D in Pharmacology/Toxicology/Biological /Life Sciences/ Biotechnology from a recognized University

OR

1st Class Post Graduate degree in Pharmacology/Toxicology/Biological /Life Sciences/ Biotechnology from a recognized University along with 4 years R&D experience in the required subject.

OR

Second class Master's Degree in any of the above subjects along with Ph.D. degree from a recognized university or equivalent.

OR

BDS degree recognized by DCI with five years' experience in relevant subject after BDS degree.

Desirable

Experience in Clinical Research. Good English writing skills, knowledge of clinical trials and drug regulatory procedures.

Job Description

To review, compile data on clinical trials, report writing and handling tasks as assigned in the Clinical Trials Registry – India.

Emoluments (pm)

Rs.64000/-plus HRA (Medical)
Rs. 51000/- plus HRA (Non-medical)

Age

Not exceeding 40 years. Relaxable up to 5 years for Government servants and SC/ST/OBC candidates.

General terms & conditions for the post are as follows:-

1. Since the post is purely temporary, the incumbents selected will have no claim for regular appointment under ICMR or continuation of his/her services in any other project.
2. The appointment is terminable with one month notice period from either side without assigning any reason and the tenure would be reviewed periodically on the basis of performance and suitability.
3. No other allowance/facilities other than consolidated salary shall be extended during the entire period of the project.
4. Age relaxation is admissible in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates, Retrenched Government Employees, Departmental Candidates (including project), and Ex-servicemen in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government time to time. Age concession to the extent of service rendered in other research projects will also be admissible for experienced and skilled persons.
5. Leave shall be as per Institutional policy for project staff.
6. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC will be as per Govt. of India norms.
7. No TA/DA etc. will be given to attend the written test/interview.
8. Qualification and experience should be from a recognised university/organization/institution.
9. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification and the decision of the Selection Committee will be final.
10. Experience should have been gained after acquiring the minimum essential qualification.
11. Mere fulfilling the essential qualification does not guarantee selection.
12. Director, NIMS, reserves the right to consider or reject any application/candidature.
13. Submission of wrong or false information during the process of selection shall disqualify the candidature at any stage.

Application received after the last date or incomplete in any manner will be summarily rejected without any intimation. After scrutiny, eligible candidates will be informed by email and may be required to appear for the written test/interview with all original documents & one set of attested copies.
